

AGREEMENT FOR INTER-DISTRICT
STUDENT TRANSFERS
FARWELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR

Students who transfer to Farwell ISD while residing in other school districts are subject to certain conditions. Inter-district transfers are a privilege granted by the receiving district, and not a right of students living outside of the district. Farwell ISD retains the right to accept or reject any and all transfer applications, based on an individual evaluation of:

1. **Grades/Test Scores**
2. **Attendance – Including excessive tardies**
3. **Discipline infractions**
4. **Potential adverse effect of the transfer on the financial well-being of the District**

Farwell ISD administration screens applications for inter-district transfers. Except as mandated under Civil Order 5281, the acceptance or rejection of a student transfer shall not be made with regard to race, religion, color, sex, disability or national origin. As part of this screening process, applicants can expect the administration to do the following:

1. **Meet with the parent(s)/guardian and student regarding the potential student’s school history and records;**
2. **Consider heavily the potential student’s grades, test scores, attendance (tardies), and discipline at his/her previous school.**

Inter-district transfer students accepted and enrolled in Farwell ISD are screened annually to confirm their continued eligibility for transfer status the next school year. The transfer student’s grades, attendance (tardies), and discipline referrals are the primary factors to be considered for maintaining a student’s inter-district transfer.

Should any of these instances occur, the Farwell ISD administration will determine the future status of the student’s transfer. If the transfer is revoked, the parent and the district of the student’s residence will be notified, and the student must be immediately re-enrolled in the home district of the parent/guardian’s choice. A revocation of the transfer shall be effective on the date of notice to the parent/guardian of the revocation. If the student and/or parent disagree with the decision of the administration, a conference with the Superintendent may be requested in accordance with District Policy FNG (LOCAL). All requests for conferences must be submitted in writing to the Superintendent’s office on a form available through the District. The Superintendent will schedule the conference on the matter in accordance with FNG (LOCAL). The student’s revocation shall be in effect pending the dispute resolution process.
